

**Accelerated English: Final Report**

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## **Executive Summary**

As of Fall 2017, San Diego City College has committed to an accelerated pathway for Basic Skills English students to transfer-level English. All Basic Skills English students will now reach transfer-level English through the completion of one accelerated course, ENGL 047A. Over the past few years, multiple annual reports were created to examine the success of the accelerated pathway in getting students to reach and complete transfer-level English. The positive results led to the institutionalization of the accelerated pathway; this report provides the final data to compare the accelerated and non-accelerated pathways.

As a result of increasing emphasis on the accelerated pathway, enrollment in ENGL 047A has increased by 951% from Fall 2012 to Fall 2016. On average, the accelerated pathway attracted students who were more likely to be younger, first-time to college students, attending full-time, or have lower placement levels in reading and writing. While students in the accelerated pathway demonstrated higher success in Basic Skills English, and higher term and annual persistence rates, the greatest advantage of the accelerated pathway appeared in subsequent enrollment and success in transfer-level English. Over the past five years, the accelerated cohorts have demonstrated a consistently higher subsequent enrollment rate and subsequent success rate than the non-accelerated cohorts.

The accelerated pathway has also demonstrated success in reducing disproportionate impact on student subgroups. Disaggregated by ethnicity, all outcome data for the accelerated pathway show narrowed or nonexistent achievement gaps for African American and Latino students as compared to other ethnicity groups.

## Introduction

## **Program Description**

In an effort to improve Basic Skills student success, City College began offering English 265B, a pilot accelerated Basic Skills English course, in Fall 2010. The goal of the course was to minimize exit points along the developmental (Basic Skills) English pathway and increase the percentage of students that progressed to, and succeeded in, transfer-level English. In Fall 2011, San Diego City College adopted the accelerated course model and the course number changed to 047A. The 047A course is open to students at all reading and writing placement levels and combines a series of four Basic Skills courses into a one-semester preparatory course designed to provide the skills necessary to produce successful college-level papers in all subject areas. The fourunit course takes a thematic perspective, within which students learn to develop arguments and strengthen critical thinking, reading, organizing, and writing skills at an accelerated pace.

Students who complete English 047A are eligible to enroll in transfer-level composition courses, English 101 and English 105. In contrast, the non-accelerated Basic Skills reading sequence includes two three-unit courses, English 042 (College Reading and Study Skills I) and English 048 (College Reading and Study Skills II); the nonaccelerated Basic Skills writing sequence includes two three-unit courses, English 043 (English Review) and English 049 (Basic Composition). Thus, without acceleration, a student who places at reading level 30 (R3) and writing level 30 (W3) must complete four courses (English 042, English 043, English 048, and English 049) in order to enroll in a transfer-level composition course, English 101 or English 105. The figure below illustrates the Basic Skills reading and writing pathways to transfer-level English at City College. As of Fall 2017, the nonaccelerated pathway has been discontinued, and only the accelerated 047A course is offered to new Basic Skills English students.





Figure 1. English Course Sequence Relative to Placement

## Methodology

This report examines student characteristics, enrollment, and outcomes for students enrolled in English 047A and compares them to students who enrolled in a course within the traditional Basic Skills pathway (ENGL 042, 043, 048, or 049). Performance measures are also compared based on the course of enrollment for students in the traditional pathway versus the placement level of students taking accelerated English, as shown in Figure 2. The results from this secondary comparison appear in the last table in each section of results (Tables 1.14, 2.13, 3.10, and 4.10).

Only students enrolled in Basic Skills English courses were included in the report. Student outcomes (Tables 2.1 through 2.13) reflect only enrollments in Basic Skills English courses, and exclude other courses students might have taken at the same time. Students may enroll in multiple non-accelerated Basic Skills English courses simultaneously (reading and writing) and a small number of accelerated students simultaneously enroll in courses from the traditional pathway.

### **Operational Definitions**

**Headcount:** The individual count of students, or unduplicated headcount. Drops, never attends, cancelled, and tutoring classes are excluded.

**Enrollment:** The total number of seats enrolled or duplicated headcount as of census. Drops, never attends, cancelled, and tutoring classes are excluded.

Retention Rate: The percentage of enrollments completed with a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD out of total official census enrollments. Tutoring, and cancelled classes are excluded.

Success Rate: The percentage of enrollments completed with a grade of A, B, C, or P out of total official census enrollments. Tutoring, noncredit, and cancelled classes are excluded.

**GPA:** Grade point average, including only Basic Skills English courses.

**Persistence Cohort:** First-time to college students enrolled during fall terms.

**Term Persistence:** The percentage of official census enrolled students in a fall term who received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD and who enrolled in at least one course in the subsequent spring term and received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or RD (SDSU, tutoring, and cancelled classes are excluded).

Annual Persistence: The percentage of official census enrolled students in a fall term who received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or RD and who enrolled in at least one course in the subsequent spring and fall terms and received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or RD in each term (SDSU, tutoring, and cancelled classes are excluded).

Subsequent Enrollment: The percentage of students who successfully complete a Basic Skills English course and then subsequently enroll in ENGL 101/105 out of the number who enrolled in the Basic Skills English course(s). Cancelled classes are excluded. Cohorts were tracked through 2016/17.

Subsequent Success: The percentage of students who successfully complete a Basic Skills English course and then subsequently enroll in ENGL 101/105 and complete the course successfully with a grade of A, B, C or P out of the number who enrolled in the Basic Skills English course(s). Cancelled classes are excluded. Cohorts were tracked through 2016/17.

## **Results**




Figure 3. Section Offerings of Basic Skills English Pathway Courses at City College

Section Count. Section offerings for Accelerated English have nearly doubled each year since 2012/13. Section offerings for the traditional pathway have decreased across all courses since they peaked in 2014/15 (see Figure 3).

#### **Student Characteristics & Outcomes**

- *Headcount.* The proportion of Basic Skills English students at City College who enrolled in the accelerated rather than the traditional English pathway increased by 31 percentage points (PP) to 35% from Fall 12 to Fall 16, 29 PP to 33% from Spring 13 to Spring 17, and from 0% to 11% between Summer 12 and Summer 16 (see Table 1.2). Student enrollment patterns in the accelerated and traditional pathways exhibited similar distributions of gender, ethnicity, and first generation status, but varied by a number of other demographic and academic characteristics.
  - Gender. Female students comprised more of the students enrolled in the accelerated and traditional Basic Skills English pathways (57% and 55% average in the past five fall terms; see Table 1.3).
  - o Ethnicity. In Fall 16, nearly three quarters of the accelerated and traditional pathway students identified as Latino (74% and 71%). African American students comprised 10% of the accelerated students in Fall 16, compared to 12% of the non-accelerated students (see Table 1.4).
  - o Age. Accelerated students were more likely to be aged 24 years or less compared to those in the traditional pathway (84% and 74% in Fall 16; see Table 1.5). Spring-enrolled students in the accelerated pathway saw a decrease in students aged 24 years or less from 81% in Spring 16 to 72% in Spring 17. Students in the traditional pathway aged 24 years or less remained consistent at 70% from Spring 16 to Spring 17.
  - o First Generation Status. Among both accelerated and traditional pathway students, the proportion of students who were first generation to college was similar over the past five fall terms (42% and 44%; see Table 1.6).
  - o Enrollment Status. While the majority of students (57%) enrolled in accelerated English from Fall 12 through Fall 16 identified as first-time to college, students enrolled in the traditional pathway were more likely to be continuing at the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) (54%; see Table 1.7).

- Over the past five fall terms, first-time to college students in accelerated English decreased by 14 PP to 50%, continuing students decreased by 14 PP to 20%, and current high school students increased from 0% to 17%.
- Tutoring Participation. Although students in the traditional Basic Skills English courses were overall less likely to receive tutoring than those in ENGL 047A, the proportion of students in accelerated English who did not utilize tutoring services increased by 42 PP from Fall 12 to Fall 16 (5% to 48%; see Table 1.8). Use of tutoring among non-accelerated students remained fairly stable.
- o Course Load. In Fall 16, 51% of students enrolled in either Basic Skills English pathway were enrolled full-time at SDCCD; however, the proportion of full-time students in ENGL 047A had decreased from 69% in Fall 15 (see Table 1.9).
- o First-Time to College Status. Students in the accelerated pathway were more likely to be first-time to college students. However, the proportion of first-time to college students in the accelerated pathway fell by 15 PP in fall terms from 2012 to 2016 (see Table 1.10).
- o Reading & Writing Placement Levels (Original). Students in the accelerated pathway were more likely to have placed at the lower level Basic Skills reading and writing courses than those in the traditional pathway (see Tables 1.11 and 1.12). In other words, students whose original placement level would require three or four Basic Skills courses to reach transfer-level were more likely to participate in the accelerated pathway.
- o Math Placement Level (Original). No major differences in original math placement levels appeared, on average, between students in the traditional and accelerated English pathways (see Table 1.13).
- Enrollments. While enrollment in Accelerated English at City College has increased by 810% between 2012/13 and 2016/17, enrollment in the traditional English pathway decreased by 30% (see Table 2.4). In 2016/17, ENGL 047A enrollments comprised 27% of the Basic Skills English pathway, an increase from 14% in 2015/16. Enrollment distributions display similar patterns when compared to headcount distributions.
- **Retention.** The retention rates for students in the accelerated and traditional basic skills English pathways both averaged 88% over the last five years (see Table 2.4). Examining averages over the past five years, few notable differences emerged when the results were disaggregated. Non-tutoring students were more likely to be retained in the non-accelerated pathway than the accelerated pathway (see Table 2.9).
- Success. Students enrolled in accelerated English were slightly more likely to succeed in their Basic Skills English courses than those enrolled in the traditional basic skills English pathway in 2016/17 (72% and 69%; see Table 2.4) and as an average over the last five years (73% and 72%). Examining averages over the past five years, few notable differences emerged when success was disaggregated. Non-tutoring students were more likely to successfully complete their course(s) in the non-accelerated pathway than the accelerated pathway (see Table 2.9).
- GPA. Averaging the past five years, the GPA for accelerated English classes was 0.16 points higher when compared to classes in the traditional basic skills English pathway (2.91 and 2.75; see Table 2.4).
- Term and Annual Persistence. Over the past five years, accelerated students demonstrated a slightly higher term persistence rate as compared to students on the traditional pathway (83% and 82%) and a distinctly higher annual persistence rate (66% and 61%; see Table 3.1).
  - o Gender. Though term persistence rates disaggregated by gender did not demonstrate major differences between accelerated and traditional students, male students in the accelerated pathway demonstrated higher annual persistence than male students in the traditional pathway. Averaging the past four years, accelerated male students showed an annual persistence rate of 65%, compared to 58% among traditional male students (see Table 3.2).

- o Ethnicity. Over the past five years, African American students in the accelerated pathway have demonstrated higher average term persistence (84% and 74%) and annual persistence (75% and 51%) as compared to African American students in the traditional pathway (see Table 3.3).
- o Tutoring Participation. Averaging the past five years, non-tutoring students in the traditional pathway demonstrated higher term and annual persistence than non-tutoring students in the accelerated pathway. Non-tutoring accelerated students demonstrated a 59% term persistence rate and a 36% annual persistence rate, as compared to a 78% term persistence and 58% annual persistence among non-tutoring traditional students (see Table 3.6).
- Subsequent Enrollment and Success in ENGL 101/105. On average over the past five years, students in the accelerated pathway enrolled in ENGL 101/105 at a rate of 61%, as compared to a non-accelerated rate of 46%. Enrollment rates were lower in both pathways for the 2016/17 cohorts, because those students have had less time to enroll. Similarly, the average success rate in ENGL 101/105 was 47% for accelerated and 37% for non-accelerated students (see Table 4.1). Across all five years, subsequent enrollment and success rates were always higher for the accelerated students as compared to the non-accelerated.
  - o Gender. In the accelerated pathway, female students show higher subsequent enrollment rates in ENGL 101/105 than male students (63% and 59%), as well as higher success rates (50% and 42%; see Table 4.2). However, these differences also appear among students in the non-accelerated pathway.
  - o *Ethnicity*. In the non-accelerated pathway, African American and Latino students enrolled in ENGL 101/105 at rates lower than students of other ethnicities (41% and 46% versus 50%). In the accelerated pathway, not only did African American and Latino students close the gap, they enrolled in ENGL 101/105 at higher rates than students of other ethnicities (63% and 62% versus 58%). The same pattern emerged in success in ENGL 101/105, with African American and Latino students performing worse than other students in the non-accelerated pathway (33% and 36% versus 42%), but better in the accelerated pathway (50% and 47% versus 44%; see Table 4.3).
  - o Age. In the accelerated pathway, students aged 24 years or less demonstrated a higher subsequent enrollment rate than those 25 and older (63% and 55%; see Table 4.4). Though not as strong, this pattern also appears in the non-accelerated pathway. However, this pattern nearly disappears when looking at subsequent success.
  - o English Placement/Enrollment Levels. The benefits of the accelerated pathway are evident when looking at student outcomes based on placement/enrollment levels. In the non-accelerated pathway, students who enrolled in the two lowest levels of Basic Skills English showed subsequent enrollment and success rates in ENGL 101/105 that were 18 to 29 percentage points lower than the students who enrolled in the two highest levels of Basic Skills English. However, in the accelerated pathway, students who placed at the level of the two lowest Basic Skills English courses performed comparably to those who placed at the level of the two highest courses, with differences of only zero to four percentage points (see Table 4.10).
