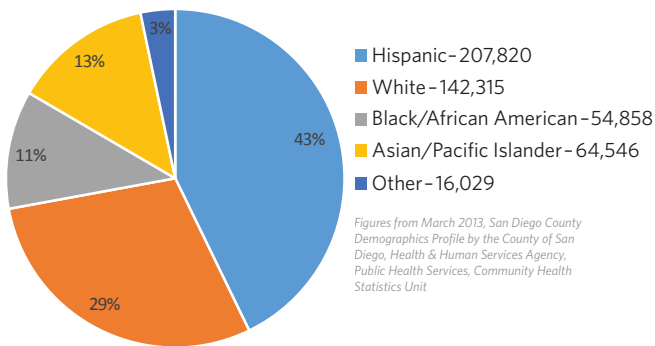


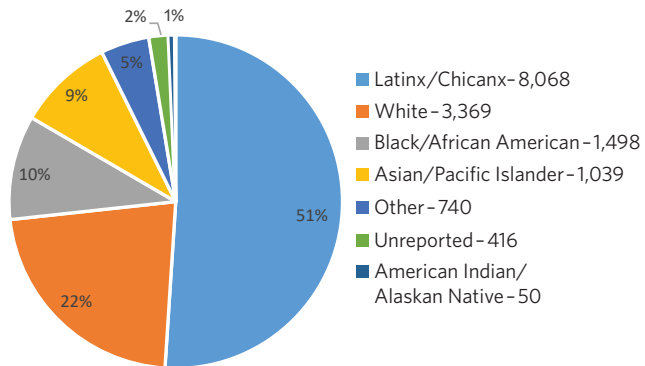

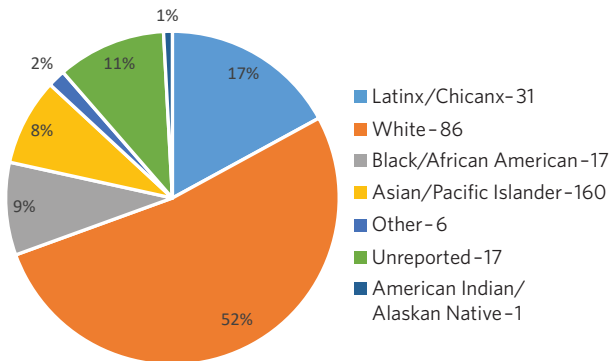
Central San Diego Ethnicity



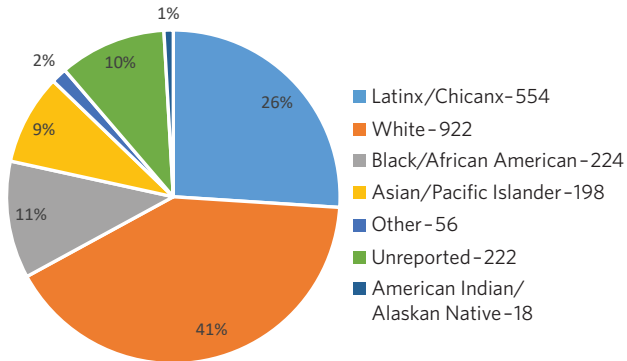
SDCC Student Ethnicity

SDCC Employee Ethnicity

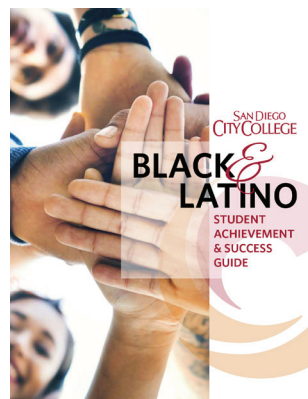

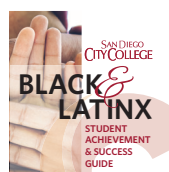
